Minimum Software Requirements

Look over the software programs that are already on your computer. Do you have any of the following?

- Word processing software such as Microsoft Word
- Graphic program such as Photoshop
- Presentation program such as PowerPoint
- Spreadsheet program such as Excel

If you already have these basic programs, you don't need to do anything. If you don't have them, you need to purchase software with those programs. One great option available to anyone is the Open Office software suite, which includes all of the software programs you would find in a typical office software package, such as Microsoft Office. The software is compatible with most standard office programs, which means it can open files like Word document from Microsoft, and save them as Word documents as well. The best part is Open Office is available to download for free! That's right... it's free! It's an open source project that anyone can enjoy and share freely. Just go to the [Open Office web site](#) and download the suite. You should be able to complete most of your assignments with the software programs included in the Open Office suite.



Minimum Hardware Requirements

These are the bare minimum hardware requirements for taking a Keystone course. Using a 56 K modem to access the Internet will mean long waits, but if that's all you have, then that's all you have.

A portable flash drive is very handy for saving your files.



You may have to do a Disk Clean-Up procedure on a daily basis if all you have is the minimal RAM on your computer. This will keep your computer running fast. If your hard drive is over 50% full, save your work to a portable device like a flash drive, CD-ROM, or even a floppy. It's always a good idea to save your work to another location anyway. Hard drives do crash.

Here's the list of the minimum hardware requirements:

- Pentium processor with Windows 98 or higher
- 56 K modem or network access
- Internet provider with SLIP or PPP
- 8X or greater CD-ROM
- 64 MB memory RAM
- Hard drive with 40-50 MB space available
- 15" monitor, 800 X 600, color or 16 bit
- Sound card/speakers
- Keyboard and mouse
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 6.0 for PC with plug-ins

Your computer hardware is important, but you won't be able to complete and submit assignments without software.
